SUBJECT: Pets and Wild Animals

REFERENCE: PI POLICY

SECTION 1 PURPOSE

1.1 To establish a policy to ensure a healthy and safe campus environment.

SECTION 2 SCOPE AND APPLICABILITY

2.1 This policy is applicable to all members of the Petroleum Institute (faculty, staff and students), and visitors.

SECTION 3 DEFINITIONS

3.1 Guide Animals: Animals trained to assist individuals with disabilities.

SECTION 4 POLICY

4.1 Pets and wild animals are not permitted on PI property.

SECTION 5 BACKGROUND OR EXCLUSIONS

5.1 To the extent that published information may conflict with this policy, this policy shall supersede that information.

SECTION 6 GENERAL PROVISIONS

6.1 The presence of pets and wild animals on the PI facilities is a cause for concern as it represents a:

6.1.1 safety hazard from possible bites and scratches.

6.1.2 health hazard from animal droppings, hair and dander that could lead to allergies and respiratory problems, and

6.1.4 hygiene hazard since we serve food in our facilities

6.2 All members of the PI community should:

6.2.1 Avoid feeding, petting or otherwise encourage any animals, birds or insects on PI property.

6.2.2 Refrain from bring brining pets of any kind on PI property, unless they are "Guide Animals".
